### **Reflection from Mrs. Paschall**

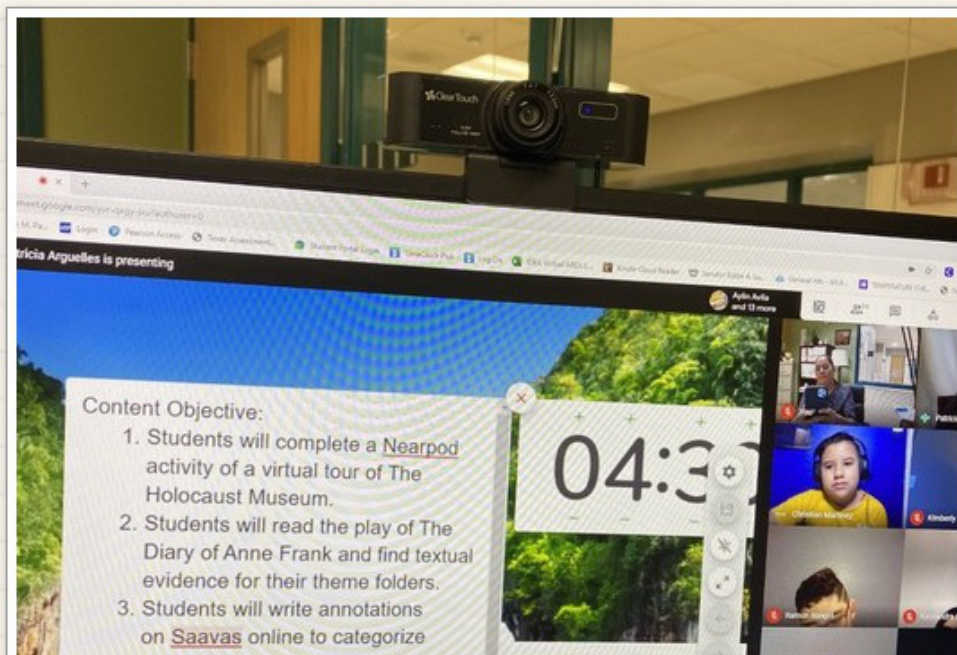
Lion Team:

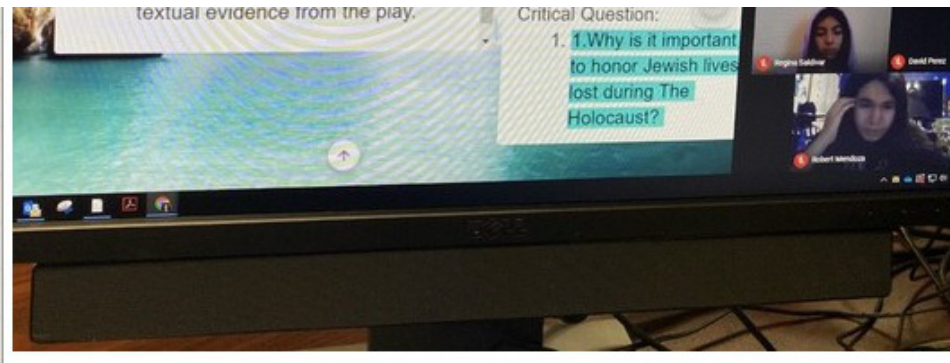

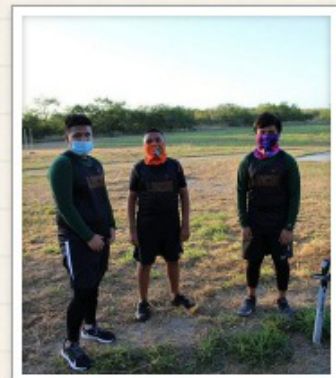
