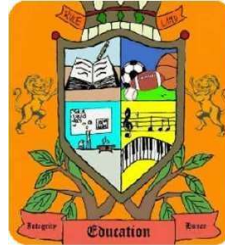

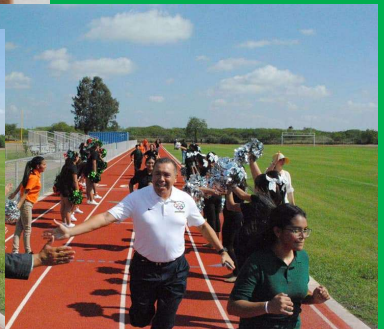
## Lucio Middle School 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Pledge
